TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

Rebates are available to non-residential customers of the Utility. All products must be in use in facilities in the Utility service territory. The applicant shall be an end-user (i.e., not a Vending Miser wholesaler, distributor, or installer).

2. APPLICATION PERIOD

The program is offered January 1 through December 31 of the respective calendar year. Due to limited funding, this rebate offer can be withdrawn at any time without notice, and is available on a first-come, first-serve basis. All projects must be pre-approved by the Utility to qualify for a rebate.

3. INSPECTION AND VERIFICATION

The Utility reserves the right to inspect the Customer's facility through on-site visitations before and after new equipment installation or inventory to verify rebate eligibility.

4. INSTALLATION AND REBATE AMOUNTS

Qualifying equipment must be installed and operational within six (6) months of application approval. Additional time may be granted subject to the Utility's pre-approval. In no case will the rebate paid by the Utility exceed the purchase price of the equipment. The maximum rebate amount may be limited.

5. INVOICE AND PAYMENT

When the purchase is completed, the Customer must notify the Utility and submit original invoices specifying the quantity and price of all materials purchased, the date ordered, installation costs, and applicable taxes. After satisfactory review of the invoices and on-site verification, a rebate check will be issued to the Customer. Please allow 60 days from the date of on-site inspection for delivery of payment.

6. EQUIPMENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for a rebate, the Vending Miser installation must meet the following conditions:

- a.) Refrigerated vending machines only.
- b.) Vending machines that contain non-perishable goods only.
- c.) Indoor vending machine locations only.
- d.) Machines not located in areas with constant activity (24-hours) only.

7. TAX INFORMATION

The Utility will not be responsible for any tax liability imposed as a result of the rebate payment(s). Customers are advised to consult their tax advisors for detail. Customers must submit the appropriate Tax ID or Social Security Number on the application form.
